The South Side Pharmacy was located on 19 Friend St. Charleston, S.C. Friend Street was later renamed Legare Street.

**Scope and Content Note:**

The Prescription Record Book from the South Side Drug Store, 1888-1891, contains prescriptions from physicians and other druggists such as W.M. Ryan M.D., A.O. Barbot Chemist and Apothecary, Pankins Pharmacy, and more. In addition, the record book holds a letter from Thos. H. Reynolds Steam Power Granite and Marble Works and two sales records from Dr. H. Baer, Wholesale Druggist.
