**Biographical Note:**

Richard, James Howard, and James Brockington Jarrott and Peter Brockington Bacot were family members from the Florence County, South Carolina area. They practiced medicine as well as maintained plantations and pharmacies in Florence. Detailed personal information can be found in the collection and other secondary source material.

**Scope and Content Note:**

The Jarrott Family Papers, 1850-1990, consist chiefly of photocopies of documents relating to physicians in the Jarrott and Bacot(e) families of South Carolina. These materials were collected by Emory Jarrott of Savannah, Georgia. Documentation includes wills, military muster rolls, obituaries, genealogies, secondary source material, typescripts and photocopies of correspondence, birth, marriage and death certificates, and original correspondence between the Waring Historical Library staff and Emory Jarrott. The above listed materials document Jarrott family members engaged in medicine, including Richard, James Howard, and James Brockington Jarrott as well as others. Of particular interest are documents relating to the 1865 murder of Dr. James Howard Jarrott of Florence, SC at the hands of Lewis J. Harrall, who was subsequently executed for the crime. Also included are photocopies from the 1830-1862 church record book from Florence County which identify African-American members of Old Mispah Church, including their names, ages, and owners. In addition to documenting the aforementioned individuals, the collection provides genealogical and personal information about a great number of Jarrotts, Bacots, and related lines.
