Biographical Note: Theodore Brevard Hayne was born in Congaree, South Carolina on August 3, 1898. His father was James Adam Hayne, South Carolina Health Commissioner. In his adolescence, Hayne began working for the U.S. Public Health Service, assisting in malaria research. After receiving his bachelor's degree from the Citadel in Charleston, South Carolina, he received his medical degree from the Medical College of South Carolina in 1927. He interned at the U.S. Government Hospital in Ancon, Canal Zone. In June of 1928, Dr. Hayne was hired to work for the Rockefeller Foundation Yellow Fever Commission in West Africa. Dr. Hayne married Roselle Hundley in 1930. After contracting yellow fever, Dr. Hayne died in July of 1930.

Scope and Content Note: The Theodore Brevard Hayne, M.D. Correspondence, 1906-1951, 1995, .25 cubic feet, consists of Dr. Hayne's correspondence, both personal and professional, as well as photocopies of his correspondence. Correspondents include Dr. Hayne's mother, father, wife, and colleagues, and the letters span the period from his childhood until

his death in 1930. The collection also includes two letters written to his family after his death. The collection also includes transcripts of many of Dr. Hayne's letters. Dr. Charles S. Bryan, Hayne's biographer, completed the transcription. The original correspondence has been arranged chronologically, followed by the photocopies and transcripts. Original copies of the photocopied letters are in the possession of the Hayne family.
