Biographical Note:

Lula Fulton was born on May 18, 1908 in Spring Gully Community, Georgetown Co., South Carolina. Her parents were James Ervin Fulton and Mrs. Mary Wheler Fulton. Miss Fulton attended the School of Nursing at the Medical College of the State of South Carolina and graduated in 1933. She married Samuel Gordon Vereen on April 26, 1936 in Dillon, SC and became Lula Fulton Vereen. Miss Fulton had two sons, Samuel G. Vereen Jr., and David Vereen. She died on April 16, 1989.

Scope and Content:

The Lula Fulton Composition Books, 1931-1932, consists of four composition books containing handwritten notes from Mrs. Vereen's lecture classes at the Medical College of South Carolina. The composition books include notes handwritten in pencil or pen, as well as loose papers that are typed and handwritten, also containing notes pertaining to the lectures. The classes covered include Medical Diseases, Eye and Ear, Mental and Nervous Diseases, Nose and Throat, Psychology, Orthopedics, Communicable Diseases, Pediatrics, Surgical Diseases, and Obstetrics. Notes are dated, organized by lecture, and include hand-drawn diagrams, identification of symptoms, treatments, and definitions of various medical practices. Loose papers include exam questions and answers, study guides, essays, and additional lecture notes.
