Summary: Dr. Victor E. Del Bene was Medical Director of the MUSC Medical Center as well as a faculty member in the College of Medicine, Division of Infectious Diseases, in 1989. The interview begins with a brief conversation between Dr. Del Bene and Dr. W. Curtis Worthington, Jr., who sat in on the interview. The discussion then turned to the days leading up to Hurricane Hugo's landfall. Dr. Del Bene recalls the decisions he made to ensure the safety of patients, staff, and the hospital and clinical facilities. A few areas of concern he touched upon included decreasing the number of staff and patients in the hospital, power outages, flooding, and loss of water. The interview also includes discussions on staff and patients' reactions to the storm, damage sustained by the hospitals and St. Luke's Chapel, and recovery efforts. A significant portion of the interview pertains to Dr. Del Bene's involvement in the St. Luke's Chapel Restoration Committee.
