Scope and Content Note:

The Register of Infectious Disease, 1902-1911, was recorded by the Board of Health and documents infectious disease in the city of Charleston. The volume is divided into sections each one recording a specific disease, including typhoid, tuberculosis, smallpox, diphtheria, croup, scarlet fever, and beriberi. Each section records date of report, name of patient, age, race, residence, disease, name of physician and remarks.
