BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

After graduating from Clemson University, William M. Simpson, Jr. attended the Medical University of South Carolina. After commencement in 1972, he remained at MUSC to complete his post-graduate studies in Family Medicine. In 1975, he became a member of the MUSC Family Medicine faculty with an interest in ethics and geriatric medicine. He was certified with the American Board of Family Practice and has a Certificate of Added Qualification in Geriatrics. He served as a colonel in the Army Reserve and was mobilized during Operation Desert Storm. He was also the designated mobilization officer and periodic Chief of Family Practice at Fort Bragg, North Carolina.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The William M. Simpson, Jr., M.D. Records, circa 1981-1992, includes nine folders and is organized into two series: Scripts and What's Your Diagnosis?. The Scripts series contains copies of the scripts "Family Medicine in South Carolina: A Report" and "History of Medicine in South Carolina" as well as screen slides for the "Family Medicine" script. The What's Your Diagnosis? series includes correspondence, a certificate, news clippings, and brochures regarding Dr. Simpson's participation in the What's Your Diagnosis? quiz competition. What's Your Diagnosis? is a quiz competition where physicians from across the nation competed in teams to solve a mystery diagnosis with the symptoms provided. This series also contains photographs and a video of the competition.
